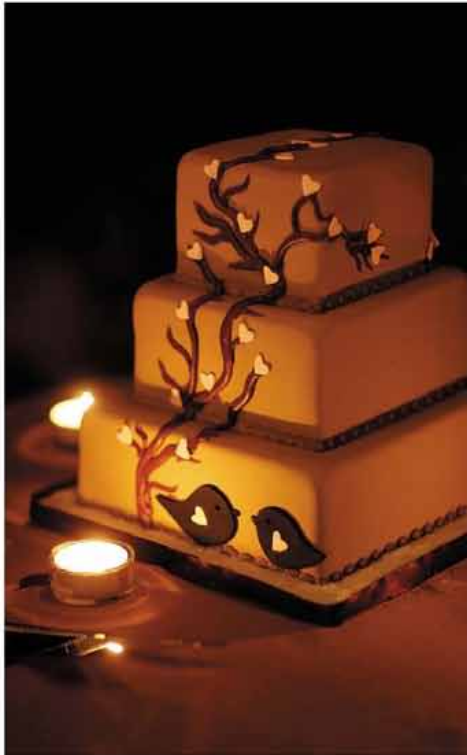
Mindi and Anthony met on Match.com and from the first meeting they were inexplicably drawn to each other and soon were inseparable.
